

**San Pedro Democratic Club**  
**March Club Meeting Minutes**

1. **Call to Order:** 7:20 pm by President Carrie Scoville.  
**In Attendance:** President: C. Scoville; VP Programs: L. Bassett; VP Membership: S. Ross; Treasurer: T. Butler; Secretary: Absent (L Bassett: substitute); 50/50 Raffle: J. Burger; Number of attendees: 30.  
**VIP's in attendance:** Congresswoman Barragan; State Senator Bradford; Former LA City Councilman R. Farrell; Club presidents; J Burger and E. Duvali. Also, several neighborhood council members.
2. **Approval of Agenda** – President Scoville asked to amend agenda to include VIP guests Congresswoman Barragan and State Senator Bradford and endorsement of Javier Perez candidate for Judge Seat 84 (no democratic opponent). **Moved: R. Farrell; 2<sup>nd</sup> J: Allen. Approved.**
3. **Remarks: Congresswoman Barragan-** Spoke about the March for Our Lives, no legislation likely as Republicans worry about reelection. She didn't support omnibus bill. No DACA. Must take back congress.  
**Senator Bradford** – commented on difficulty getting healthcare for all passed; importance of judicial elections; need for diverse jury system; need for bail reform.

**Superior Court Judge Office 4-** Candidates: A. Coletta & V. Saucedo (Lazaro Cuevas). Paper ballot given to members. **Alfred Coletta received 60% of votes. Club endorsed candidate- Judicial Office 4.**  
**June Ballot Propositions:** L. Bassett – 5 ballot propositions. Provided copies of Props 68 & 69 for members to read and discuss.  
**Endorsement Prop 69 Transportation Taxes:** Jeff Kiernan from CA League of Cities. This prop ensures gas tax money can only be used for transportation and infrastructure.  
**Voice vote to endorse Prop 69: Unanimous**
