**Proposition 68, Parks, Water** – Shannon Ross led discussion. Flyer distributed, information from ballotpedia and San Diego Uion Tribune. **Club endorsement for Yes on Prop 68 moved by P. Stanyo, 2<sup>nd</sup> by R.G.Wong, unanimous approval by voice vote.**  
**Proposition 70, Cap and Trade** – Linda Bassett led discussion. Yes would mean 2/3 vote needed to fund green projects, no would mean simple majority. **Club endorsement for No on Prop 70 moved by J. Burger, 2<sup>nd</sup> by P. Stanyo. Approved by voice vote with one vote in opposition.**
